1. This application under Order XXIII Rule 1(3) read with Section 151 CPC has been filed on behalf of the applicant/petitioner for withdrawal of the present civil revision petition.
2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that for the reasons assigned in the application, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the matter any further. It is requested that the petition may be allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn *simpliciter*.
3. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondent submits that the present civil revision petition is sought to be withdrawn since certain facts have been omitted on the part of the petitioner, which plea is challenged by ld senior counsel for the respondent present on



advance notice submitting that the real intention is to wriggle out of certain admissions. In any case, this Court is not required to delve into the merits of the same.

4. However, since much time of the Court has been taken in considering the present civil revision petition, the same is dismissed as withdrawn without liberty to file afresh, with the direction to the petitioner/applicant to deposit a sum of Rs. 25,000/- with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee.

5. The application is disposed of accordingly .
