BAIL APPLN. 2510/2024

Mr. Utkarsh, learned APP appearing for the State draws attention to order dated 24.05.2022 made by a Co-ordinate Bench of this court in BAIL APPLN. No.1606/2022 titled *Amar vs. The State (NCT of Delhi) & Anr.*, whereby an earlier bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

Learned APP further submits, that trial in the matter is at its fag-end; and as recorded in order dated 03.05.2024 by the learned ASJ, Tis Hazari



Courts in SC bearing No.123/2018, of the 24 prosecution witnesses only 03 police witnesses (including 02 investigating officers) are left to be examined; and the next date before the learned Trial Court is 06.08.2024.

In the circumstances, Mr. Amjad Khan, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present bail petition, with liberty to file afresh, after the prosecution evidence in the matter is complete.

The petition is disposed-of as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed-for; without making any observations on the merits of the matter.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed-of.
