1. The Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of CrPC has been filed on behalf of the petitioners for quashing of FIR No. 326/2023 for the offence under Section 498A/406/34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Rani Bagh, Delhi.

2. A Status Report has been filed on behalf of the State wherein it is submitted that the Charge Sheet already stands filed wherein the husband, mother-in-law, father-in-law, have been charge sheeted under Section 498A/406/34 of the IPC while husband, Mr. Siddhartha Garg has additionally been charge sheeted for the offence under Section 377 of IPC. The brother-in-law, Mr. Saurabh Garg and sister-in-law Ms. Shruti Garg had been placed in Column No. 12. Since the charge sheet has already been



filed, the petitioner is at liberty to raise all the contentions mentioned herein before the learned trial court.

3. The Petition is accordingly disposed of along with the pending application.

4. It is hereby made clear that there is no expression on the merits and the trial court shall proceed in accordance with law.
