1. Exemptions allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present application is filed seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.164/2021 dated 24.06.2021 registered at Police Station Special Cell for offences under Sections 21/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 ('NDPS Act').
4. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the bail application filed by the applicant on an earlier occasion was dismissed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court by a detailed



order dated 13.12.2023.

5. He submits that the trial is not proceeding and the applicant is in custody since 24.06.2021. He submits that he will be satisfied if the learned Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
