1. This application has been filed to restore the contempt petition which has been disposed of by order dated 27th November 2024.
2. By the said order, it had been recorded that the Special Leave Petition filed by respondents had been dismissed and the steps for purpose of compliance of directions contained in *para 8* of the order dated 01st March 2024 passed by the Division Bench in ***W.P.(C) 10193/2019*** shall be carried out within four weeks.
