An application under Section 439 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.') has been preferred on behalf of the petitioner for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 0145/2023, under Sections 393/307/34 IPC and Sections 25/27 Arms Act, registered at PS: Krishna Nagar.
