1. A brief background of this case has been recorded in the last order by the learned predecessor bench. Upon service of notice, learned counsel for respondent has appeared and submits that the present writ petition can be disposed of in terms with first part of prayer clause (a). Briefly stated, the issue revolves around the Provisional Rent Assessment Report dated 28.02.2023. The petitioner is stated to have already given a representation dated 01.06.2022 referring to the previous demand, which representation remains not decided.

2. As requested by both sides, considering the overall circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to treat the present petition as a representation and dispose of the same by way of



reasoned order within six weeks after giving a personal hearing to the petitioner and/or his representatives.
