1. This petition, under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ["the Act"], has been filed for extension of the mandate of the learned Arbitrator, who is in *seisin* of disputes between the parties under a Collaboration and Joint Venture Agreement dated 03.07.2015.
2. The pleadings in the arbitral proceedings were completed on 13.01.2022. The parties extended the mandate by mutual consent for a

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period of six months until 01.09.2023. The mandate was thereafter extended by an order of this Court dated 24.01.2024 in OMP (MISC) (COMM) 669/2023 until 30.06.2024.
