This petition has been filed for setting aside of order dated 01<sup>st</sup> February, 2017 passed by the ASJ, Dwarka Courts arising out of an FIR No.200/2008 under Sections 304/34 IPC PS Delhi Cantt. It is noted by the perusal of the impugned order that the respondents were discharged under Sections 304/34 IPC but were charged under Sections 323/34 IPC. The trial in respect of the offences charged under Sections 323/34 IPC is complete and the accused had been acquitted by order dated 18<sup>th</sup> March, 2024.
