ORDER

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1. A request for adjournment is made on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 3 on the ground that the learned Senior Counsel is indisposed due to a medical emergency.
2. Mr. Manish K. Jha, learned counsel for the petitioner, states that a moratorium is in place in respect of respondent No. 1 - Shipra Estate Limited, by the order of the National Company Law Tribunal dated 24.01.2024.
