2. The petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A (4) and (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the arbitral tribunal for a period of one year from 26.05.2024 to make and publish the award.
5. It is stated that due to voluminous record, the proceedings could not be completed.
