Present petition has been filed challenging the orders dated 18.03.2024 and 17.05.2024. However, during the course of submissions, counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the direction is issued to the learned trial court to first decide the application for discharge of the accused persons and then proceed in accordance with law.

Issue notice. Learned APP for the State has accepted the notice.

In view of the submissions made, learned M.M. is directed to dispose of the application filed for the discharge of the accused persons and then



proceed in accordance with law. However it is made clear that this court has not heard the petitioner on merits and expression made herein shall tantamount to be an expression on the merits of the case. Learned MM shall decide the application for discharge of the accused persons without being influenced by the order of this court.

The petition along with the pending application stands disposed of.
