3. By way of present petition, the petitioner seeks direction to the Trial Court to adjudicate and dispose the Petition bearing No. MT Case 175/2022 titled *Shilpi Vijay vs. Arnab Nag*, under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking interim maintenance expeditiously in a time-bound manner.

4. The only grievance which has been agitated by way of present petition is that despite the aforesaid Petition under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 being filed in the year 2022, the same is being adjourned on technical reasons for one day to another day and even the interim maintenance sought in said Maintenance Petition under Section 125



of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is yet to be disposed of even after a lapse of one and a half year.
