ORDER

1. It is contended by Mr. Trivedi that the issue which arises for consideration in the present petition is covered by the judgment of the Supreme Court in the case of *Director (Admin and HR) KPTCL and Ors v. CP Mundinamani and Ors, CA 2471/2023* decided on April 11, 2023. He states that the benefit thereof must be given to the petitioners herein.

2. On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondents states that appropriate shall be, that the present petition is considered as a representation on behalf of the petitioners to be decided by the respondents, keeping in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court as referred above.

3. Noting the submission of the learned counsel for the respondents, we direct the respondents to consider and decide the petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioners, keeping in view the judgment of the Supreme Court as referred above.



4. If the petitioners are entitled to the benefits thereof, the same shall be released to them within six weeks thereafter.
5. If the respondents are of the view that the benefits are not available, the reasons thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioners within the same period to enable the petitioners seek such remedy as available in law.
6. Petition is disposed of.
