1. Exemption is granted subject to all just exceptions.
2. The petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. This is a petition under Section 29A(4) and (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 6 months w.e.f. 28.08.2024 to make and publish the Award.
5. It is stated that the matter is at the stage of final arguments and the arbitration proceedings are quite extensive and involve voluminous



pleadings. Thus, the present petition has been filed.

6. Issue notice. Ms. Tuteja, learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice and has no objection to the petition being allowed.
