1. Exemption is granted subject to all just exceptions.
2. The petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A(5) read with Section 29A(4) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal for concluding the arbitral proceedings and passing the final award.
5. It is stated by Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner that the cross-examination of the claimant's witness is taking time.



6. Issue notice.
7. Mr Gupta, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the petition being allowed.
8. For the reasons noted above, I am of the view that sufficient cause has been explained for the delay.
