CRL.M.A. 7670/2025 (for exemption)

1. Exemption is granted, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The Applicant shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules, before the next date of hearing.
3. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.A. 7669/2025 (seeking revival of the petition)

4. Through this application, the Petitioner seeks a direction to the Trial Court to dispose of Crl. Case No. 6161 of 2019, which is pending



adjudication, in a time bound manner.

5. It is noted that on 16th February, 2025, this Court has already disposed of the instant writ petition, with a direction to the Trial Court to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible.

6. The Court has been informed that the charges have not yet been framed. In this regard, Ms. Priyam Agarwal, counsel for State submits that this delay is due to the fact that the Complainant had filed two protest petitions against the chargesheet, which resulted in filing of a supplementary chargesheets.

7. In light of the foregoing, in the opinion of this Court, the directions issued on the previous date for an expeditious trial are sufficient and no further directions are required in this regard.

8. The application is disposed of.
