1. Exemption is granted subject to all just exceptions.
2. The petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A (4) and (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 12 months w.e.f. 12.09.2024.
5. It is stated that the delay in concluding the Arbitral proceedings and passing the Award has occurred due to the documents involved in the arbitration proceedings being voluminous and the dispute between the parties being technical in nature.
6. I am satisfied that sufficient cause has been shown for extension of



the mandate of the arbitral tribunal.

7. For the said reasons, issue notice.
