1. Exemption is granted subject to all just exceptions.
2. The petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 6 months.
5. It is stated that the arbitral proceedings is at the stage of final arguments and since, the records pertaining to the arbitral proceedings are voluminous, the delay has occurred.
6. Hence the present petition has been filed.
