1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application is disposed of.

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3. By the present petition, the petitioner seeks expeditious disposal of FIR No. 78/2018.
4. No order sheet has been filed in the present case. The petition does not indicate as to why the trial has been taking time. It is common knowledge that trials in criminal cases take a substantial period of time since *inter alia*, a number of witnesses have to be examined.
5. This Court does not consider it apposite to pass any order



which would be in the nature of passing directions to the learned Trial Court to conduct the trial in a particular manner.

6. If at any stage, the trial is delayed at the instance of prosecution, appropriate order can be passed on an application being filed by the petitioner.

7. The present petition is dismissed with the aforesaid observations.
