1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application is disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 9118/2023

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.63/2019 registered under Sections 323/354/354B/509 IPC at P.S. Chandani Mahal, New Delhi on the ground that the parties have amicably settled their disputes.
2. As per the allegations levelled in the FIR, on 15.05.2019 at around 2:15 AM, the petitioner abused and beat respondent No.2.
3. Learned APP for the State submits that in the present case the petitioner is the only accused person and respondent No.2 is the only complainant/victim.
4. Learned counsels for the parties submit that the parties, have entered



into an out-of-court settlement and in terms of the settlement, respondent No.2 is now left with no claim whatsoever against the present petitioner.

5. The petitioner and respondent No.2, who are present in the Court, have been identified by their respective counsels and the Investigating Officer.

6. The petitioner has shown remorse for his conduct and he undertakes not to repeat the same in future. Respondent No.2 states that she has entered into the aforesaid settlement out of her own free will, volition and without any coercion. She further states that she has no objection if the present FIR and consequent proceedings are quashed.

7. Learned counsels for the parties submit that there is another connected FIR being FIR No.112/2019 registered under Sections 323/354/354A/506/34 IPC at P.S. Chandni Mahal, Delhi which has also been quashed vide CRL.M.C. 8775/2023.

8. The parties shall remain bound by the statements made in Court today.

9. In view of the above facts and since no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the present criminal proceedings, it is directed that the aforesaid FIR and the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

10. With the above directions, the petition is disposed of.
