1. The writ petitioner is aggrieved by the seizure of goods which was effected on 30 July 2024. However, and as is evident from the record, the respondent is yet to pass an order of adjudication.

2. Consequently, while we find no justification to entertain the writ petition at this stage, we are of the considered opinion that the application for provisional release which is pending before the respondents would warrant expeditious consideration.



3. Accordingly and subject to due verification of all facts and contentions on merits being kept open, we direct the respondents to attend to the application for provisional release of goods and ensure the same is disposed of with due expedition and preferably within a period of three weeks from today.

4. All rights and contentions of respective parties on merits are kept open.
