1. This is an application for early hearing preferred by the appellant. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and, therefore, pray that the matter be taken up today itself and disposed of in terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 29.10.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to this request.

3. In the light of this stand taken by the parties, the application is, for the reasons stated therein, allowed and the appeal is taken up for consideration.

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4. The present appeal has been preferred under Section 19 of the Family



Courts Act, 1984, assailing the judgment and decree dated 20.07.2024 passed by the learned Family Court, South East, Saket Courts, New Delhi in HMA No.59/2019.
