ORDER

1. This writ petition has been preferred on behalf of the Petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking the following reliefs:

“A. Issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to conduct interview of the petitioner for the post of Deputy Manager (Project Erection/Construction) –at E4.

B. Issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representation submitted by the petitioner with respect to the petitioner’s interview for the post of Deputy Manager (Project Erection/Construction) –at E4.”
