1. Exemption is granted subject to all just exceptions.
2. The petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A(4) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 4 months for concluding the arbitral proceedings and passing the final award.
5. It is stated that the arbitration proceedings are at the final stage of arguments.
6. Issue notice.
7. Ms. Fatima, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and states that she has no objection to the petition being allowed.
