ORDER (ORAL)

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1. This is a petition under Section 29A(4) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996¹ for extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal presently *in seisin* of the disputes between the parties.

2. It is stated that the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal is expiring on 8 September 2024.

3. Learned Counsel for the respondent has no objection to extension of the mandate, as sought.

4. Accordingly, the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal stands extended by nine months with effect from 8 September 2024.
