1. Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.') has been preferred on behalf of the petitioner for quashing of FIR No. 167/2023 under Section 16 of the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976, Section 75 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2015, Section 14 of the Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986 and Sections 374/323 IPC registered at Police Station Greater Kailash.
2. Issue notice. Learned APP for the State appears on advance notice and accepts notice.
3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that present petition has been



preferred since despite order dated 27.09.2023 in CRL.M.C. 7057/2023 and order dated 01.04.2024 in CRL.M.C. 2545/2024 passed by this Court, proceedings are still pending investigation and final report is yet to be filed.

4. Learned APP for the State, on instructions of IO, informs that case of the petitioner is under investigation and submits that final report shall be filed in accordance with law within a period of four weeks.

Taking the statement of learned APP for the State on record, petition is accordingly disposed of. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
