1. By way of present petition, the petitioners, who claim to be the wife and children of respondent No.2, are aggrieved by the fact that the respondent No.2 has not only vandalized the house belonging to the father of the petitioner No.1 but also has physically assaulted the petitioners and has extended threats towards them.
2. Issue notice.
3. Learned ASC for the State accepts notice and submits that on receipt of the complaint, initially a *kalandra* was registered and subsequently, an FIR bearing FIR No.327/2024 under Sections 115(2)/126(2)/324(5)/351(2), BNS 2023 at P.S. Ashok Nagar came to be registered. Further, it is submitted that in the proceedings under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C., respondent No.2 has also been bound down by way of a personal bond. She further submits that the concerned beat officer, I.O. and the SHO shall



provide their mobile numbers and the beat officer will also make regular visits to the house of the petitioners.

4. In view of the above, the petition is disposed of alongwith the pending applications.

5. Needless to state that the petitioners shall be at liberty to seek additional remedies, as may be available under the law.
