3. This is a petition filed under Section 29A(4) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 6 months for concluding the arbitral proceedings and passing the final award.
4. It is stated that the evidence of the claimant's witnesses are over, however, the cross-examination of respondent's witnesses is taking some time.
