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1. Learned counsel for the parties state that the suit has been settled in mediation. A Settlement Agreement dated 16.04.2024 has also been placed on record. It is signed by the plaintiff through his constituted attorney, and by the defendant through its authorised signatory. The power of attorney, executed by the plaintiff, in favour of the signatory, has also been placed on record. The signatory is the attorney through whom the plaintiff has filed the present suit also. Similarly, the board resolution authorising the signatory on behalf of the defendant, to sign the Settlement Agreement, has also been placed on record. The Settlement Agreement is also signed by learned counsel on both sides and by the learned Mediator.
