ORDER

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1. The petitioner is seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for the wilful disobedience of the directions contained in order dated 01.05.2024 in W.P.(C) 5290/2024.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent/Bank is present on advance notice.
3. In short, the representation of the petitioner was directed to be considered by the Competent Authority by passing a speaking order in accordance with the law within eight weeks.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent present on advance notice submits that, in terms of the directions of this Court, a speaking order has been passed on 20.08.2024 and the petitioner has since been intimated about the same.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the copy of the



order has not been supplied. Hard copy of the same is placed on the record and a copy of the same is supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner in the court.

6. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner requests permission to withdraw the present petition with the liberty to institute appropriate proceedings in case the petitioner is aggrieved against the impugned order.

7. The Registry is directed to digitize the reply and be placed on the record.

8. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty so sought.
