ORDER

06.11.2024

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1. These petitions have been filed for quashing of FIR No.470/2024 under Sections 376D/377/323/506/120B/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sagarpur, *qua* all three petitioners.
2. This Court on 2nd September 2024 and 11th September 2024 had passed directions that no coercive steps be taken against petitioner subject to their joining and cooperating in the investigation.
