3. The present application is filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 172/2019 dated 30.05.2019, under Sections 302/307/120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Jyoti Nagar.
