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1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the CrPC seeks following prayers:-

“It is most respectfully prayed that the Hon’ble Court be graciously pleased to

(i) Issue an appropriate writ(s) in the nature of Mandamus to immediately restore the possession of the said property in Khasra No. 151, 152/1 (250 sq yds) to the petitioner and her family.

(ii) Issue an appropriate writ not to transfer the said property or create any third party interest.

(iii) Issue appropriate strictures against the local police officials who have illegally dispossessed the petitioner and her family.

(iv) Issue such appropriate writ(s) as this court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

(v) Pass such further or other order(s) as this court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.”

2. Learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State, on advance notice, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that the



property which is the subject matter of the present petition has not been locked by any order from the respondents.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to initiate appropriate remedies in accordance with law.

4. Leave and liberty granted.

5. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.

6. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
