1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

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2. This petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 0635/2022 registered at Police Station: Najafgarh, Dwarka, Delhi under Sections 323/341/506/427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short, 'IPC').

3. The parties have *inter alia* settled their disputes and have executed a Memorandum of Understanding dated 20.01.2023 recording the terms thereof.



4. Keeping in view the above, and the principles laid down by the Supreme Court in *Gian Singh v. State of Punjab*, (2012) 10 SCC 303; *Parbathai Aahir @ Parbatbhai Bimsinh Karmur & Ors. v. State of Gujarat & Ors.*, (2017) 9 SCC 641 and *State of Haryana & Ors. v. Bhajan Lal & Ors.* 1992 Supp (1) SCC 335, the FIR No. 0635/2022 registered at Police Station: Najafgarh, Dwarka Delhi under Sections 323/341/506/427 IPC and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.
5. The parties shall abide by the terms of the aforesaid Settlement/Memorandum of Understanding.
