1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The petitioner is seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for the alleged wilful disobedience of the directions of this Court contained in the order dated 18.12.2023 as modified by subsequent order dated 29.02.2024 passed in WP(C) No.16240/2023.
4. Learned counsel for DDA is present on advance notice.
5. Long and short of the matter is that the representation of the



petitioner has not been considered within six weeks as directed by the aforesaid orders.

6.
