2. The petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

O.M.P.(MISC.)(COMM.) 715/2024

4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A(4)&(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 6 months for concluding the Arbitral proceedings.
5. It is stated that the arguments of the petitioner and the respondent have taken place and now the matter is only fixed for rejoinder arguments of the petitioner.
6. Issue notice. Mr. Nakul, learned counsel for the respondent accepts



notice and has no objection to the petition being allowed.

7. I am satisfied that sufficient cause has been shown for the delay.

8. For the said reasons, the petition is allowed and the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal is extended for a period of 6 months from today to conclude and make and publish the Arbitral Award.
