ORDER

13.11.2024

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1. Status report has been filed.
2. On 11th June, 2024 at 16:27 hrs., during a pre-embarkation security check at IGI Airport, Terminal-3, the machine detected three 9 mm live bullets in baggage of the petitioner.
3. On preliminary inquiry, petitioner disclosed that he had absolutely no knowledge of how these bullets were present in his bag. He had arrived from Manali by bus to Delhi just the day before and hired a taxi to reach IGI Airport. He had handed over his baggage for check-in and was later informed that three rounds of bullets were found in his check-in baggage, and he was



not in conscious possession of the same.

4. There is no other assertion by the State that petitioner has any previous involvement, or that he was in conscious possession.
5. In view of these circumstances, and considering the submissions, the FIR stands quashed and proceedings emanating therefrom.
