BAIL APPLN. 3361/2024

1. Petitioner has approached this Court seeking interim bail for a period of one month in FIR No.1193/2023, dated 08.09.2023, registered at Police Station Nihal Vihar for offences under Sections 306/34 IPC, on the ground that the Petitioner is suffering from Tuberculosis.
2. Material on record discloses that the Petitioner was released on interim bail for a period of one month by the Trial Court *vide* Order dated 06.08.2024. Material on record further reveals that the Petitioner was undergoing treatment as an outpatient in the Government Hospital and his treatment can be continued from jail hospital.
3. In view of the fact that the Petitioner suffers from Tuberculosis, this Court directs that proper diet and adequate treatment be provided to the



Petitioner and if necessary the Petitioner be kept in Jail Hospital, if required.

4. It is always open for the Petitioner to approach the competent Court with requisite medical documents in case the condition of the Petitioner deteriorates in future.

5. With these observations, the Petition is disposed of along with the pending applications, if any.
