1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.

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2. After some arguments, counsel for the appellant seeks to withdraw the present appeal, with liberty to take the pleas raised in the appeal before the Family Court where the divorce petition is pending.

3. To be noted, the appellant has filed a divorce petition *qua* which, *via* the impugned order dated 17.08.2023, issues have been framed, while disposing of the respondent's application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

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4. The appeal is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to raise pleas raised in the appeal before the Family Court.

4.1 Needless to say, since we have not considered the matter on merits, the Family Court will consider the contentions put forth before it as per law.

5. Consequently, the pending applications shall stand closed.
