1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application is disposed of.

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3. The petitioner is seeking initiation of the contempt proceedings against the respondents for the alleged wilful disobedience of the order of this Court dated 09.09.2024 passed in W.P.(C) No.12230/2024.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents/bank is present on advance notice.
5. In short, despite a direction by this Court that no recovery shall be effected from the account of the petitioner/customer, it appears that on 10.09.2024 a system generated lien was created. However, on the



representation preferred by the petitioner, the entry has been reversed only last evening and the amount stands credited to his account.

6. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as satisfied. However, at the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, it is directed that the respondents shall pass appropriate instructions to the their 'customer care unit' so that no further auto generated calls or otherwise seeking demand of the disputed amount are made to the petitioner.
