1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

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2. The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a direction to the respondents to grant him his due increments in light of the decision of the Supreme Court in *Director (Admn. & HR) KPTCL & Ors. versus C.P.Mundinamani & Ors.* 2023 SCC OnLine SC 401.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the present, the petitioner will be satisfied, in case the respondents are directed to examine his claims in light of the decision of the Supreme Court in



Director (Admn. & HR) KPTCL & Ors. (supra) in a time bound manner.

4. Issue notice. Ms.Amrita Prakash, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. She has no objection if the petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take a final decision regarding the petitioner's claim in a time-bound manner.

5. In light of this fair stand taken by the respondents, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the petitioner's claim as raised in the present petition within a period of eight weeks from today and pass a reasoned and speaking order *qua* the petitioner.

6. Needless to state, while taking a decision on the petitioner's claim, the respondents will take into account the decision dated 11.04.2023 of the Supreme Court in **Director (Admn. & HR) KPTCL & Ors.** (supra) read with the clarificatory order passed by the Supreme Court in S.L.P. (C) 4722/2021 on 06.09.2024. It is further made clear that in case the petitioner is aggrieved by any order passed by the respondents, it will be open for him to seek legal recourse as permissible in law.
