1. Exemptions allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

3. The present petition is filed challenging the order dated 24.07.2024, passed by the learned Family Court, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi, in MT Case No. 187/2024, pursuant to which the *ad-interim* maintenance has been fixed as Rs. 8,000/- per month.

4. Clearly, the impugned order is only an *ad-interim* order. It is not disputed that the application for relief of interim maintenance is still pending consideration before the learned Family Court. In such circumstances, any petition under Section 397 of the CrPC, challenging the interlocutory order would not be maintainable at this stage. The petitioner is at liberty to file an appropriate application or reply opposing the grant of maintenance or for the modification of



any *ad-interim* order.

5. The petition is dismissed with the aforesaid observations.
