1. Exemption is granted subject to all just exceptions.
2. The applicant(s) shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

O.M.P.(MISC.)(COMM.) 790/2024

4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 6 months for concluding the arbitral proceedings and passing the final award.
5. Issue notice.
6. Mr Bajaj, learned counsel accepts notice for the respondent and opposes the application and states that the petitioner has filed extra copies of the statement of claims before the Arbitral Tribunal which led to the delay.
7. However, I am of the view that in the interest of justice, since filing of extra copies of statement of claims was an inadvertent error on behalf of the



petitioner, the delay needs to be condoned.

8. For the said reasons, as last and final extension 6 months are granted to the Arbitral Tribunal from 05.10.2024 to 05.04.2025 to conclude the arbitration proceedings and make and publish the award.

9. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
