1. Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 ('BNSS') has been preferred on behalf of the petitioners for quashing of FIR No. 0097/2024 under Sections 419/420 IPC registered at P.S.: Palam Village.
2. Issue notice. Learned APP for the State and learned counsel for respondent No. 2 alongwith respondent No.2 in person appear on advance notice and accept notice.
3. Learned APP for the State, on instructions of IO, informs that matter



is still pending investigation and petitioner No.1 (Monu Sharma) is involved in another FIR.

4. At this stage, after making some submissions, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the petition with liberty to file afresh after filing of final report by the investigating agency.

5. Taking the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners on record, petition is accordingly disposed of with liberty as prayed. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.

IO is further directed to record a supplementary statement of respondent No.2 as it is submitted by her that she is not interested in pursuing the present case.
