ORDER

23.10.2024

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1. The petitioner has filed the present petition impugning an order in original dated 28.08.2024 passed by the Joint Commissioner of Customs, Delhi, whereby the gold *kada* and gold disc which were found in the possession of the petitioner and were detained, have been directed to be confiscated. In addition, the petitioner has also been imposed a penalty amounting to ₹1,40,000/- under Sections 112(a) and 112(b) of the Customs Act, 1962.
2. Admittedly, the petitioner has a remedy of an appeal.
3. In these circumstances, we do not consider it apposite to entertain the



present petition. The same is accordingly disposed of. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.

4. It is clarified that if the petitioner files an appeal within a period of two weeks from date, the same would be considered by the Appellate Authority, uninfluenced by the question of any delay.
