ORDER
06.11.2024

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1. This petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 693/2019 under Sections 323/325/341/356/506/34 IPC at P.S. Uttam Nagar, based on settlement arrived at between the parties with the facilitation of the Delhi Mediation Centre, Dwarka Courts, on 22nd March 2024, which is on record of this Court.
2. Petitioner no.1-2 and respondent no. 2 are present in Court and are duly identified by IO and the respective counsel.
3. As per the settlement, final outstanding balance of Rs. 3 lakhs is being paid today *vide* DD no. 491840 drawn on IndusInd bank; which has been handed over to respondent no.2 who has duly received it in Court. Respondent no.2 states that he has no objection to quashing of the FIR.



4. Considering the above settlement between the parties and the chances of conviction of the petitioners being remote and bleak, there is no use continuing with proceedings of the present FIR as it would be a misuse of the process of the Court and an unnecessary burden on the State exchequer. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. Consequently, the FIR No. 693/2019 under Sections 323/325/341/356/506/34 IPC at P.S. Uttam Nagar, Delhi and proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.
5. Parties shall abide by the terms of settlement.
6. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of. Pending application is disposed of as infructuous.
