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3. This is a petition seeking direction to respondent No. 1 to grant necessary permission for cutting of hazardous branches of the tree encroaching on the petitioner's property.

7. Ms. Bakhru, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 2, 3 and 4 i.e. Municipal Authorities states that whatever assistance is required by the DCF for doing the above shall be provided.

8. The petition is disposed of.

9. In case the petitioner is still dissatisfied, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the petition.
