ORDER

1. The present writ petition concerns allegations of illegal construction at premises *No. 21, Rajpur Road, Civil Lines, Delhi*.

3. 4. It is made clear that this Court has not made any observation upon the maintainability or merits of the matter.

5. The petition, alongwith all pending applications, stands disposed of with these observations.
