4. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to assail the order dated 30.12.2022 passed by the respondents in purported compliance of order dated 04.11.2022 passed in O.A. No. 1484/2022.
5. As prayed for, the present petition is dismissed with liberty to file a



comprehensive O.A. assailing the order dated 30.12.2022.
